April is Sexual Assault Awareness Month


Sexual Violence has No Boundaries!


Let's Talk About It!

ADVOCACY SERVICES



- ⇒ Offers 24-hour crisis intervention and direct services
- ⇒ Is available through calls or text
- ⇒ Will inform you of your rights and options
- ⇒ Can accompany a victim through the medical exam, police interview and all legal proceedings
- ⇒ Is an advocacy agency who offers free and confidential support for victims of sexual violence and, if requested, offer services for their friends & family
- ⇒ Can assist in providing a victim-centered coordinated response with other agencies to best meet your needs
- ⇒ Provides on-going services with children, youth, and adults (Individual, family and/ or group sessions)

Sexual violence is defined as any unwanted or coerced sexual behavior - from sexual bullying to rape.


